600 Club Tournament Rules- 2011

1. This tournament is sanctioned by Canadian Tenpin Federation (CTF) and all playing rules are applicable.
2. Only members of the National 600 Bowling Club, Inc. may enter this tournament. If you wish to receive CTF awards from your participation in this Tournament, and you are not currently a CTF member; you must purchase an Affiliate Membership from CTF (\$28.00) or a CTF participation fee (\$5.00) prior to the commencement of bowling in this tournament.
3. Entering averages will be the highest sanctioned league average of 21 games or more as of April 1, 2011, as published in your local association annual yearbook. If no 2010-11 winter average has been established, an entrant shall use the highest league average as of the end of 2011 summer season, provided 21 games or more have been bowled. **When using non-yearbook average, verification from your league secretary, Must accompany the entry.**
 - a) Rule 319a2 ~ 10 pins over average will not apply.
 - b) Rule 319d - Bowlers need not report previous prize winnings.
 - c) If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than actual, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
1. Five (5) games will be bowled on one pair of lanes.
2. A bowler may enter more than once, but cash only once.
3. Late arrivals will be permitted to bowl in the frame currently in progress. A score of zero will be given for frames missed.
4. Errors in scoring must be reported to Tournament Management. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to Tournament Management before tournament prize payments are made.
5. When there is a tie for first place in each division, co-champions will be declared. Duplicated awards will be given to the champions.
6. Prize payment from entry fees will be based on the number of entries, with at least one prize for each ten entries or major fraction thereof in each division. Distribution of prizes will be within 30 days after the end of the tournament except when CTF has authorized delay in payment.
7. Your time is automatically confirmed unless the shift first requested is filled, in the event your first choice is not available, you will be contacted.
